Additional Fees	
Exam Fees	\$384.00 entry fees for NCEA Levels 1 to 3 (Years 11-13) must be paid. <i>(Subject to increases by NZQA)</i>
Uniform	Price varies according to gender, season and optional items, allow approximately NZ \$400.
Shoes	Boys - plain black lace up or dress shoes. Girls – plain black closed in shoes, lace up or ballet strap, no heels. High-tops and patterned shoes are not permitted.
Stationery	Textbooks and initial basic stationery pack are included in the student's fees and will be provided to students. Students will need to buy their own workbooks, pens, pencils, highlighters, scissors, glue, calculator etc.
Subject Fees	Some subjects can incur additional costs and these are paid separately by the students. Examples of these may include: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Subject Courses Fees• Workbooks• Music (hire of instruments)• Maths (specialised calculators)• Trips and day excursions (vary according to subjects)• Food Technology• Art Packs
Outdoor Education	International Students pay the subsidised rate of \$350 for 2 terms or \$550 for a full year. Students may need to pay extra costs for activities throughout the year (these vary due to the season).
