<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>What qualifications do I want to gain while at school?                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All students should aim for a <b>minimum</b> of NCEA Level 2.</li> <li>University Entrance (UE) is a useful qualification even if you don't think you want to go on to university.</li> <li>Merit and Excellence grades are important for entry to University courses and for scholarships.</li> <li>Look at the National / NZ Certificates available that can lead on to apprenticeships / further study.</li> </ul> </li> <li>What Vocational area am I interested in?
