## Living in New Zealand > What to bring

- ✓ Passport and current visa to study in New Zealand
- ✓ [Travel/Medical insurance policy](#)
- ✓ Return airline ticket
- ✓ Prescription for any medications necessary
- ✓ Laptop
- ✓ Proof of purchase/receipts for any electronics e.g. mobile phone, laptop
- ✓ Adapter plug for electrical goods
- ✓ Personal items and clothes
- ✓ Spending money

### Important to remember:

- ✓ Pack your own bags. **Do not** carry anything for another person.
- ✓ When you arrive at Auckland airport you should have completed a Passenger Arrival Card.
- ✓ You must declare all food even if it is packaged. You are not allowed to bring fresh food into New Zealand.
- ✓ You should not carry a large amount of cash.
- ✓ On your arrival you will go through Passport Control, Baggage Claim and Customs.
- ✓ After this you will see one of our staff, or your homestay family, waiting for you with a sign with your name on it. You will then be taken to your new home.
- ✓ If you get lost, or cannot see your name on a sign, ring our Emergency Number **021 023 78993**.
