<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What qualifications do I want to gain while at school? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All students should aim for a minimum of NCEA Level 2. ○ University Entrance (UE) is a useful qualification even if you don't think you want to go on to university. ○ Merit and Excellence grades are important for entry to University courses and for scholarships. ○ Look at the National / NZ Certificates available that can lead on to apprenticeships / further study. • What Vocational area am I interested in? <p>COMPULSORY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English (1ENGL) OR English Internal (1ENGI) OR English for Speakers of other Languages (1ESOL) • Mathematics (1MATH) OR Mathematics Internal (1MATI) • Science (1SCIE) OR Science Skills (1SCII) <p>PREREQUISITES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Taken in Y10 or HOD Approval: 1MAOR, 1JAPA, 1MUSC, 1MUSP • All other subjects open entry, however taking the subject in Year 10 is an advantage.

<p>COMPULSORY</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • English (2ENGL) OR English Internal (2ENGI) OR English for Speakers of other Languages (2ESOL) AND / OR • Geography (2GEOG) / History (2HIST) / Social Studies (2SSS) / Media Studies (2MST) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ If you choose a Social Science instead of English then please note that UE literacy can only be obtained from external exams. If you are intending to go to the University of Auckland you must take an English course. <p>PREREQUISITES</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 14 credits at previous year level, and genuine attempt at any External Exams*.

* All students with 14+ credits in the previous year will be granted entrance to that course the following year, provided they attend and attempt their external exams. Students with fewer credits may be offered entrance depending on the standards they have passed and space being available in the course.
