If you are an out-of-zone applicant you will need to go into a ballot for the places we have available. The closing date for out-of-zone applicants is **Wednesday 2 September**. The out-of-zone ballot will be held on **Wednesday 9 September 2020** and letters to applicants will be emailed / posted by Friday 11 September.

Open Expo on Tuesday 4 August

Induction Day on Monday 23 November

On Monday 23 November we will be holding an Induction Day at Edgewater College for all enrolled Year 8 students. The day will be broken into two parts: from 9 am to 11 am we are inviting all Year 8 Pakuranga Intermediate students and between 1 pm to 3 pm we are inviting Year 8 students from our other feeder schools who are enrolled at Edgewater College for 2021. Our Induction Day will be an opportunity for us to start to get to know our enrolled students and ensure that we can best support them and their learning needs when they start at our school. Students will have a taste of the subjects we offer and meet key staff who will support them as they begin secondary school. We will also find out more about their learning interests and strengths for Mentor Class placement.

1-1 Devices at Edgewater College

Year 9 EDGE Innovation Programme

This exciting new initiative started at Edgewater College in 2019 with our first cohort of Year 9 students and continues in 2021. The programme is designed for students who wish to be involved in an innovative curriculum based on developing learners, leaders and change-makers who use knowledge meaningfully across English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies, as well as in the Arts, Technology, Health and PE and Languages. Instead of the core subjects of English, Mathematics, Science and Social Studies students will study Future Studies, Problem Solving, Community Action and Creative Design.
