PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

Kia ora koutou katoa

It has been fantastic to be able to end another challenging year with fantastic celebrations of Academic Excellence at our Senior and Junior Prizegiving's, as well as see so many proud whanau here to recognise their children's achievements. The whakatauki I shared at both these events was

E huri tō aroaro ki te rā, tukuna tō ataarangi ki muri i a koe Turn and face the sun and let your shadow fall behind you

I am very hopeful about the year ahead and what this will mean in terms of supporting our learners to achieve at the highest possible levels.

As a school we pride ourselves on being a place of innovative and exciting learning and we have some great new initiatives for the year ahead. We have looked carefully at our timetable and will be keeping with 4 x 75 minutes lessons each day, from Monday to Friday next year. Research also shows that co-curricular activities in sport, culture, interest and passion areas contribute significantly to students' leadership, communication, time management, creativity, decision-making, service and co-operation skills. In order to continue to grow these skills in our learners I am proud to announce that we will be including participation in such activities within our school timetable next year. Session 4 on a Wednesday will be an opportunity for students and staff to participate in sports, cultural, arts, music, interest and passion groups, as we continue to develop the essential future focused skills that such activities can provide for all our learners.

There are significant changes coming in the New Zealand education space - the New Zealand curriculum is being rewritten, all of the NCEA standards are being changed alongside the introduction of new literacy and numeracy standards. In order to ensure our learners are able to continue to achieve at the highest possible levels across the NCEA we will also be offering two new compulsory courses at Years 9 and 10 next year. Our Literacy Edge or LEDGE course will give every student a literacy coach who will know and set literacy targets for all learners. They will receive targeted instruction, along with key aspects of the Aotearoa Histories curriculum and

tikanga Maori. Our Numeracy Edge or NEDGE course will similarly give every student a numeracy coach to support them with their numeracy. The other aspects of the curriculum that will be included in this course are Financial Literacy, Digital Technology and cybersafety and Careers education.

She has achieved a total of 264 credits for NCEA with over 75% of them being at excellence level and over 90% at either Merit or Excellence level. In previous years she gained excellence endorsements in both Level 1 and 2 NCEA, as well as subject endorsements at Excellence level in Chemistry, English, and Mathematics with calculus, and Merit in Physics. This year in NCEA Level 3 - 46 of her 49 credits have been at Excellence level, a remarkable achievement.

Tonight, we have seen Yalda receive awards for Excellence in Level 3 English Literature, Level 3 Mathematics with Calculus AND Excellence in Level 3 Physics. She is also the very deserving recipient of a University of Otago 150th Entrance Scholarship valued at \$17,000.

Next year Yalda is attending Otago University to study a Bachelor of Health Science with the intention to transition into a Bachelor of Dentistry at the completion of her first year. This I am incredibly awed to announce all 68 of her Level 3 credits to date are at excellence level, meaning she has already attained a Certificate Endorsement at Level 3. Wow!

At prizegiving Hannah received the Barbara Hughes Trophy for the top student in Level 3 biology and the Barbara McKenzie Memorial Award for First in Level 3 English, as well as coming first in Chemistry, Music and Mathematics with statistics. Hannah was also the recipient of the Tahawai Award for all round excellence, and the Year 13 Dean's award for best representing our school values of maia, manaakitanga and manawa reka. She is also the recipient of an AUT Finding Your Greatness scholarship valued at \$23 000.

Hannah is going to study a Bachelor of Health Science, majoring in Occupational Therapy at AUT next year, and we wish her all the very best in these future students.




