| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> What qualifications do I want to gain while at school? What do I want to do when I leave school and what subjects will help me achieve this? Do I want to go to university, or do I want to go into trades/services/industries? What Vocational area am I interested in? (see right) What qualifications and courses do I need for tertiary study or for the work I hope to do when I leave school? Does my subject selection provide enough flexibility to change courses or direction in the future? To help with your course selection for next year, use the pathway map to plan where you want to go and how to get there. Any course that is **blue** means you must take it.

- **At Level One**, that means a literacy and numeracy subject has to be selected.
- If you are in **Level 2/3** and intending to go to university, you will have to select a literacy rich subject to make sure you meet the university requirements.
- If a subject is **orange**, it is either a Unit Standards course or one that is designed to help you pathway to a job/career directly out of school and not to university.
- If a subject is **green**, then it has a UE pathway, meaning the skills learnt in it will help you make the transition to level three.
- If a subject is **dark green**, then it is a UE approved subject at level 3. You will need at least 3 of these if you want to gain entry to university.
