Riverina School Charitable Trust

- Application Process -



The Riverina School Charitable Trust was established in 1999 to support former students of Riverina School who might need help at some stage after leaving secondary school to further their education, trades, or to improve their job opportunities. Each year various amounts are awarded, which can be used to meet the needs of the successful applicant e.g. IT purchases/repairs, accommodation, course fees, tools, books, furniture, transport, food, clothing, and other appropriate assistance.

Eligibility Criteria:

Applications will be accepted from former students of Riverina School who wish to apply for financial support after secondary school.

Application Dates:

The important thing is to have the application completed before the closing date:
Sunday 1 November, 2026

Applications for financial support should be made on the online application form linked here: [Application form link](#)

Note: When filling in the form, don't worry if you haven't got all the costs or course details yet; just write as much information as you have at this stage. If you need help in any way - refer to the details at the end.

What happens next:

- Applications will be reviewed by the Riverina School Charitable Trust Board, with ALL applications being considered carefully, and treated with respect and confidentiality.
- Those applicants who make the shortlist will be contacted to arrange a time to have an interview with the Trust Board to be held on Monday, 16 November 2026.
- All applicants will be notified of their success or otherwise during the week after the interviews. Whether you are successful or not, you may apply again the following year for support from the Trust.
 - Grants will be available for the use of successful applicants from February 2027.

Successful applicants will be required to:

- Submit a written report about their progress and achievements to the Trust Board when requested.
- Report to the Trust Board if unable to complete the programme, with unspent funds remaining the property of the Riverina School Charitable Trust.

The Trust Board's decision is final and will not be open for further discussion, nor will any correspondence be entered into.
